Promote mental health awareness and provide access to support resources.

Encourage open discussions about mental health, supporting a positive work Environment.

Incident Prevention:

Ensure adequate provisions are in place to control Health & Safety risks arising from work activities.

Focus on identifying and reporting foreseeable hazards; implementing suitable and sufficient control measures in order to reduce risk of personal injury and/or damage to property.

Provide appropriate information, training and supervision in order to maintain safe working practices.

Maintain a safe & healthy work environment at all times.


Implementation
